We want to make use of the resources that are available for us and turn the global as well as the regional ways of dealing with resources into the resource of our festival which is about work, wealth and both ecological and economical treasures. How do we deal with them? To which extent do they elude us?

GOLD – poverty was yesterday is a low-budget festival.



Call for Entries

For the Forum Festival 2007 titled **GOLD – poverty was yesterday**, taking place from **April 20th to May 5th 2007**, we are looking for project proposals for the festival programme from all disciplines of art.

Who can propose a project?

Anybody who lives within a 100-Euros journey radius (one-way) and who has an idea relevant to the topic: individual artists or groups of artist, cultural workers and researchers, initiatives and associations working in the field of art.

Who selects the projects?

Together with the ProgrammFORUM the festival board will come to a decision on the basis of the submitted project proposals. With regard to the board's decision any recourse to legal action shall be excluded. Direct invitations and commissions will supplement the programme.

Who organizes the Forum Festival 2007?

After 2005, the artists' association Forum Stadtpark organizes the Forum Festival for the second time. The festival is funded by the City of Graz, the Provincial Government of Styria and the Division for the Arts of the Austrian Federal Chancellery.

The festival board consists of Dieter Boyer, Hermi Ria Grabner, Anton Lederer, Ursula Obernosterer and Nora Theiss.

ProgrammFORUM, which is responsible for the content and the concept of the Forum Stadtpark, consists of Rainer Binder-Krieglstein, Dieter Boyer, Daniel Erlacher, Hermi Ria Grabner, Herwig Höller, Daniela Jauk, Monika Küttner, Judith Laister, Anton Lederer, Margaretthe Makovec, Ursula Obernosterer, Marusa Sagadin, Stefan Schmitzer and Martin G. What is the project proposal supposed to include?

- a completed application form with the personal data of the project leader
- a description of the project
- a short description of the project (½ DIN-A4 page max)
- an as expressive as possible visualization, sketch, script or other presentation of the planned realization
- the place of realization & spatial -situational requirements based on the module system
- a self-presentation incl. a documentation of the previous art activities of both the project designers and the protagonists
- a financial plan

The project proposal can be submitted in German or English.
